Kenai Peninsula Advisory Boards Seek New Members

January 31, 2023 (Soldotna, AK) –The Alaska State Parks Kenai Peninsula Regional office has opened the application process for vacancies on three Kenai Peninsula advisory boards. The Kenai River Special Management Area, Kachemak Bay State Park, and Seward State Parks advisory boards are recruiting for three positions on each citizens' advisory board for positions that are ending a three-year term.

All Alaska State Park advisory boards provide State Park managers with recommendations on management issues affecting their State Parks. The people selected for these Kenai-area positions will serve a three-year term from July 2023 through June 2026. The advisory boards typically meet once a month between September and May.
