Alaska State Parks seeks bids for Kenai-area boat launch contracts

(Anchorage, AK) – Alaska State Parks is seeking bids for contracts to provide commercial boat launch and retrieval services at the Deep Creek and Anchor River state recreation areas on the Kenai Peninsula.

The tractor boat launching service provides Alaskan residents and visitors with summertime access to Cook Inlet fisheries by using large tractors or other heavy equipment to launch trailer-transported boats on the beach at these popular state recreation sites.

The successful applicants will be awarded five-year competitive park use permits, with the option to extend an additional five years. Applications must be received at the Kenai office of Alaska State Parks no later than Monday, Dec. 14, 2020, at 4 p.m.
