## Alaskans invited to bid on 110 parcels in state land auction #489

Starting March 4, DNR will accept sealed bids for up to two parcels each from Alaska residents in person, by mail, or online until 5 p.m. on June 11, in its 2020 Alaska State Land Auction, Offering #489. The department will announce the apparent high bids for each parcel on June 24.

"Putting Alaska lands into Alaskans' hands helps residents build their dreams and fulfills our state Constitution's mandate to provide for settling the land," said Governor Mike Dunleavy. "I encourage all residents to consider taking advantage of the opportunity represented by this land auction."
