Chena River SRA shooting range closed for clean-up Saturday

(Fairbanks, AK) – The state shooting range at the Chena River State Recreation Area will be closed from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. on Saturday, May 18, to allow volunteers to help clean and maintain the facility at Mile 36.4 Chena Hot Springs Road.

A team of volunteers from Corvias, a private construction and maintenance company that maintains on-base housing at Eielson Air Force Base, will spend the day cleaning and maintaining the range. The volunteers will remove trash, level shooting benches, fill in low, wet swampy areas and build a path to the targets.
