Alaska State Parks seeking information on Angel Rocks vandalism

(Fairbanks, AK) – Alaska State Parks is seeking information about vandalism on the Angel Rocks Trail in the Chena River State Recreation Area. Angel Rocks is a popular trail located at mile 49 of the Chena Hot Spring Road. The trail consists of a 3-mile loop that leads up to several unique rock outcroppings. The trail is one of the most popular day hikes in the Fairbanks area.

Some of the rock outcroppings were recently vandalized. The vandalism consists of graffiti on the rock outcroppings and a significant amount of litter.

It is illegal to disturb, damage, deface, or remove natural objects including trees, plants, moss, rocks, gravel, or minerals within Alaska state parks. It is also illegal to litter in the state parks.

If you have any information about the vandalism, or if you witness a park violation during normal business hours, please report it to Alaska State Parks Fairbanks office by calling 451-2695. If you witness a park violation at night or on weekends, please report it to Alaska State Trooper Post in Fairbanks at 907-451-5100; the dispatcher will forward the information to park rangers.
