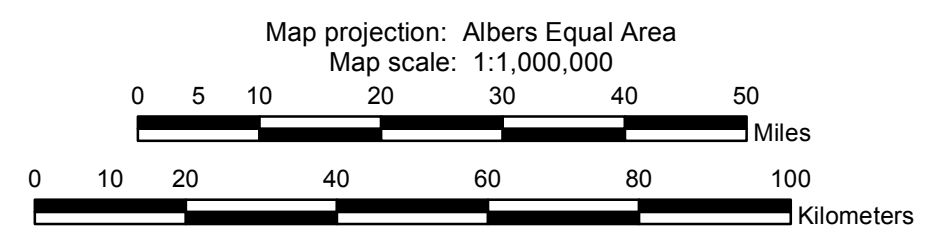


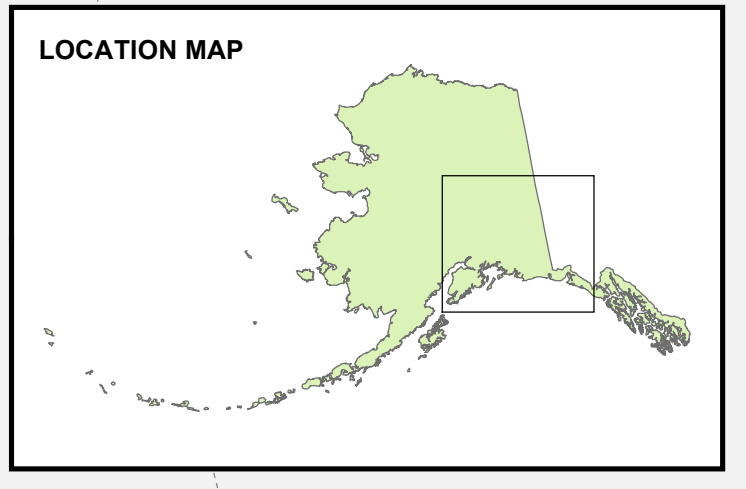

 The Alaska Maritime National Wildlife Refuge (AMNWR) is not completely depicted. Areas within it depicted are shaded. However, they are not outlined. The Alaska Maritime NWR is described as follows:
 The Alaska Maritime NWR consists of all public lands, including submerged waters and waters over submerged lands, rivers, creeks, streams, and designated coastal waters in the coastal areas and adjacent seas of Alaska within the designated coastal waters. Chukchi Sea, Bering Sea, Aleutian Islands, Alaska Peninsula, and Gulf of Alaska Coasts, and includes an unincorporated county of Alaska. State waters or waters under the State's jurisdiction are within the NWR. The NWR is a part of the Alaska National Wildlife Refuge System established October 1978.

Note: This map shows general land ownership information. When reviewing this map, please recognize that federal, ANCSA, and state land ownership is depicted hierarchically, by entire section. For example, any portion of a section that occurs within State Patented or Tentatively Approved land causes the whole section to be depicted as state land, even if the State Patented or Tentatively Approved land is only a fraction of the section, and federal land and ANCSA land also occurs in the section.
 The land ownership hierarchy is as follows:
 1. State Municipal Entitlements or Land Exchanges or Other Land Dispositions
 2. Patented Deposited Federal Lands (Native Allotments or Private Parcels)
 3. State Patented or Tentatively Approved or Other State Acquired Lands (Includes conveyances 101, 1A, 1B, 1C, 1D, 1E, 1F, 1G, 1H, 1I, 1J, 1K, 1L, 1M, 1N, 1O, 1P, 1Q, 1R, 1S, 1T, 1U, 1V, 1W, 1X, 1Y, 1Z)
 4. Alaska Native Claims Settlement Act (ANCSA) Patented or Interim Conveyed
 5. Major Military
 6. National Wildlife Refuges, National Park System Units, and National Wildlife Refuges
 7. National Wild & Scenic Rivers outside National Park System Units and National Wildlife Refuges
 8. National Forests and Monuments, National Petroleum Reserve-Alaska, National Recreation Areas and National Conservation Areas
 9. Bureau of Land Management Public Lands.
