

HOW TO EFFECTIVELY REPORT A KRPUA VIOLATION

1) SAFETY – FIRST AND FOREMOST, PROTECT YOUR PERSONAL SAFETY AT ALL TIMES

- Never confront or approach angry or intoxicated persons
- Maintain a safe distance as needed
- Depart immediately and contact law enforcement if you feel threatened

2) TAKE SOME PICTURES (STAY SAFE) Pictures are VERY important

3) CAREFULLY RECORD DETAILS OF THE VIOLATION

5) RELAY YOUR WRITTEN STATEMENT AND PHOTOS TO THE CORRECT LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY BY EMAIL, FAX, OR IN PERSON AS QUICKLY AS POSSIBLE
