HOW TO EFFECTIVELY REPORT A KRPUA VIOLATION

1) SAFETY – FIRST AND FOREMOST, PROTECT YOUR PERSONAL SAFETY AT ALL TIMES

- Never confront or approach angry or intoxicated persons
- Maintain a safe distance as needed
- Depart immediately and contact law enforcement if you feel threatened

2) TAKE SOME PICTURES (STAY SAFE) Pictures are VERY important

3) CAREFULLY RECORD DETAILS OF THE VIOLATION

Date and Time:
Exact Location:
Description of individuals, color and type of clothing, how many, etc
Description of vehicles, color, type, license plate numbers, etc
Description of the violation (what exactly were the violators doing)
Witnesses and Phone Numbers:

- 5) RELAY YOUR WRITTEN STATEMENT AND PHOTOS TO THE CORRECT LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY BY EMAIL, FAX, OR IN PERSON AS QUICKLY AS POSSIBLE
