♦RESERVED EASEMENTS:

EIN 6

A proposed trail from the shore of Uyak Bay extending westerly along the north side of an unnamed creek to Salmon Creek Lake, then along the north shore of the lake, and then southwesterly. (25-foot trail)

EIN 8

A proposed trail running southeasterly from Larsen Bay. (25-foot trail)

EIN 9

A proposed trail running southeasterly from the Larsen Bay. (25-foot trail)

EIN 11

A proposed trail running northerly from the head of Larsen Bay. (25-foot trail)

EIN 12

An existing trail from the head of Larsen Bay westerly to the Karluk River. (25-foot trail)

EIN 13a

A campsite on the right bank of the river at the Karluk River portage. (one-acre site)

EIN 13b

A campsite on the left bank of the river at the Karluk River portage. (one-acre site)

EIN 17

A proposed trail from site EIN 13a at the Karluk River portage southerly along the right bank of the Karluk River to Karluk Lake at site EIN 21. (25-foot trail)

EIN 30

A campsite on an island in the Karluk River. (one-acre site)

EIN 33

A proposed trail running southeasterly from the Karluk River near the mouth of Shasta Creek. (25-foot trail)

EIN 34

A proposed trail running southerly from the Karluk River. (25-foot trail)

EIN 47

A proposed trail running southwesterly from the west side of the Karluk River portage at site EIN 13b. (25-foot trail)

EIN 102


A campsite on the southwest shore of Harvester Island. (One-acre site)
