A proposed trail running westerly from the shore of Barling Bay at site EIN 17. (25-foot trail)

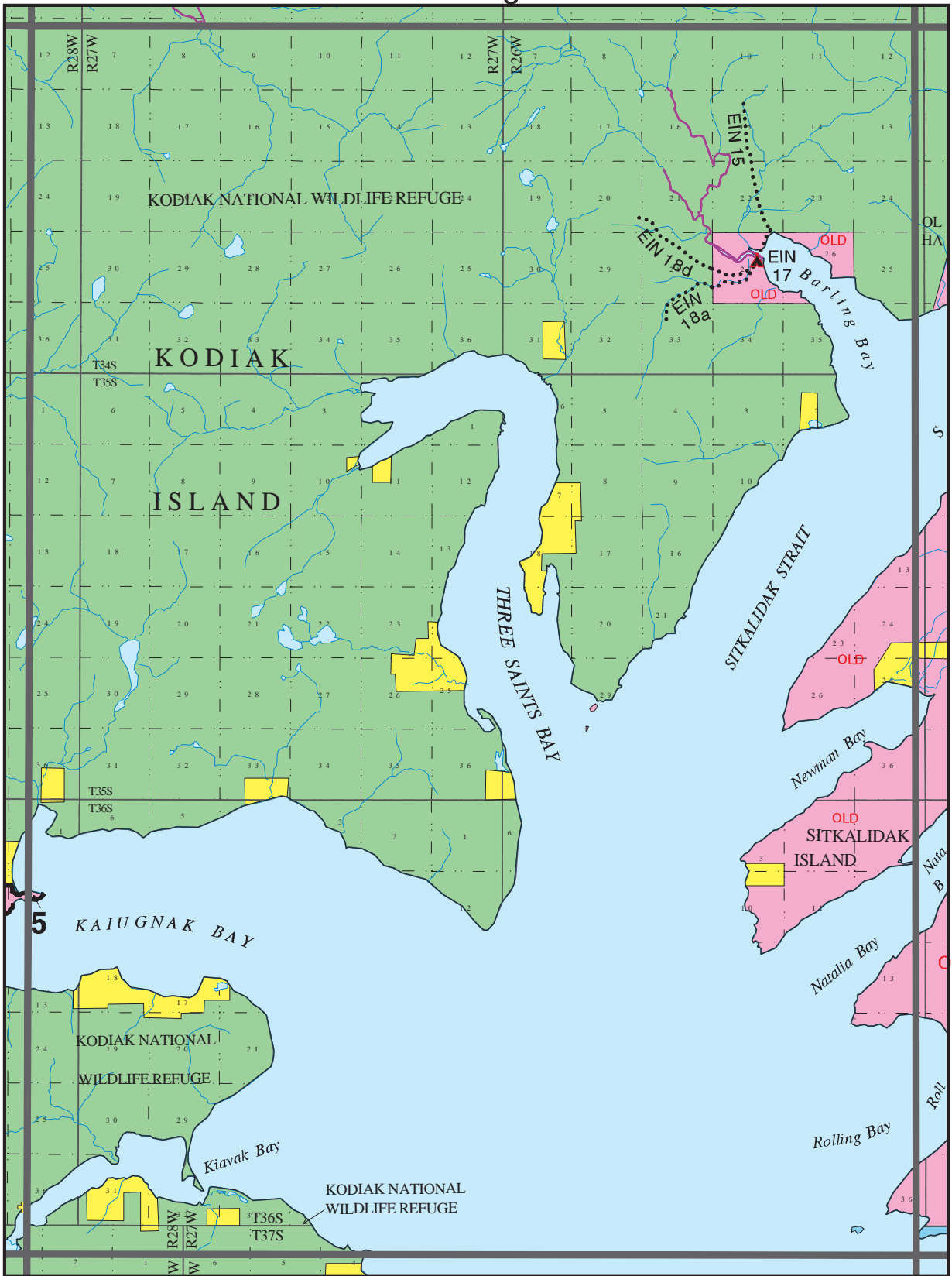
